In 2026, we're building on that foundation with the introduction of The Coral Club - a new indoor/outdoor music precinct featuring ticketed evening performances, while keeping the core festival experience freely accessible to all.

THE CORAL CLUB

New for 2026, The Coral Club transforms the Victor Harbor Town Hall and surrounding Coral Street into a vibrant indoor and outdoor music precinct.

Inside, the Town Hall becomes an intimate live venue hosting free daytime performances and three ticketed evening events across the weekend.

ACROSS THE PROGRAM

- Friday night feature act from the east coast
- Saturday interstate headliner and returning fan favourite
- Sunday seated performance from an Australian rock 'n' roll legend

Outside, the energy continues with bar service, food and casual seating, extending the atmosphere into Coral Street.

The Coral Club marks the next evolution of the festival, bringing a classic club feel to the heart of the action while remaining connected to the energy of the streets outside.

COMMUNITY & ECONOMIC IMPACT

For more than 15 years, the Victor Harbor Rock 'N' Roll Festival has drawn a broad and engaged audience, now welcoming 12,000-15,000 attendees across the weekend.

The event generates strong economic activity for local hospitality, retail and accommodation providers, with visitors travelling from across South Australia and beyond.

AUDIENCE SNAPSHOT

- Visitors to the South Coast enjoying the festival alongside local venues, markets and hospitality.

- Rock 'n' roll and classic vehicle fans who travel specifically for the event and engage deeply with its culture and lifestyle.

The festival footprint spans Warland Reserve, Ocean Street and Coral Street, driving pedestrian flow through the town centre and extended dwell time across precincts.

Free daytime programming remains central to the event, complemented by curated ticketed evening performances that support sustainable, long-term growth.

Since taking on management of the Rock 'N' Roll Festival, Fairy Pig has focused on preserving its heritage while strengthening its sustainability and long-term growth.

- Strengthened partnerships with local businesses and stakeholders
- Upgraded infrastructure across Warland Reserve
- Introduced new programming, including The Coral Club
- Secured Community Event of the Year in 2024
